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FOURTH AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

The Amended Scheduling Order (ECF No. 1040) is hereby further amended to set a new date for trial and to adjust remaining discovery and pretrial deadlines as follows:

<u>Depositions of Party Witnesses.</u> The parties shall serve any remaining expert witness supplemental disclosures related to data collected in 2019 by February 21, 2020. The parties shall complete remaining depositions of the parties' disclosed expert, fact, and third-party witnesses by March 13, 2020.

Close of Discovery. Discovery shall close on March 13, 2020.

Status Report. Not later than February 28, 2020, the parties shall file a joint status report regarding the status of settlement negotiations and the need for trial, and requesting a status conference.

<u>Pretrial Motions.</u> Pretrial motions shall be filed by March 27, 2020, and any

objections or reply memoranda shall be filed pursuant to the schedule set out in Local

Rule 7(b)-(c), such that all pretrial motions shall be fully briefed no later than May 1,

2020.

Pretrial Briefs. Pretrial briefs shall be filed by May 1, 2020.

Witness and Exhibit Lists. The parties shall exchange witness and exhibit lists by

May 15, 2020.

<u>Pretrial Conference</u>. The parties will be available for a pretrial conference on May

22, 2020, or such date thereafter as set by the Court.

<u>Trial.</u> Trial will begin on June 1, 2020, or such date thereafter as set by the Court,

and will last for up to four weeks.
